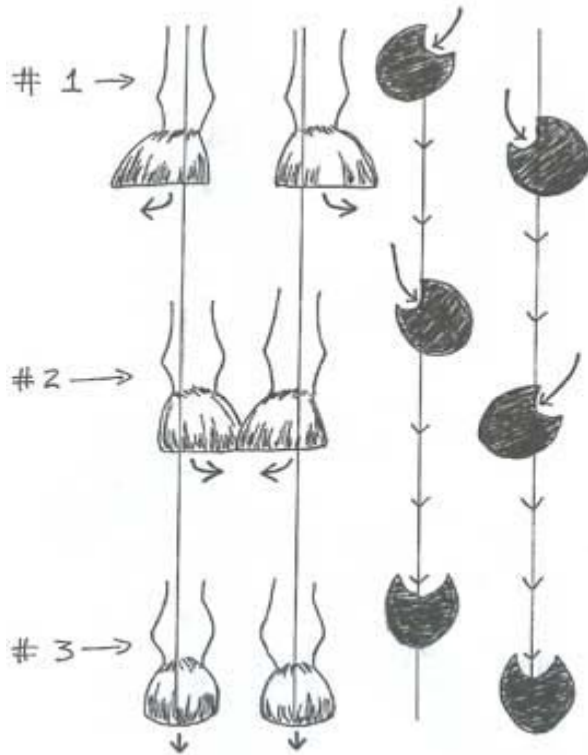


HOOF TRAVEL PATHS DIAGRAM



The diagram on the next page gives you a perspective on how a horse looks and travels with

1. Toed out feet
2. Toed in feet
3. Feet that are flat and true

Several things can cause these different looks and foot movements such as trimming inconsistencies, birth defects or chronic injuries.
